



Beeswax Wrap Recipe (with Damar Resin)

Ingredients (makes ~3 medium wraps):

- 100g Beeswax (grated or pellets)
- 20g Damar Resin (crushed or powdered)
- 10g Jojoba Oil (or fractionated coconut oil)
- Ratio: 5 parts beeswax : 1 part damar resin : 0.5 part oil

Supplies:

- 100% cotton fabric (washed & cut to size)
- Oven & baking tray (lined with parchment or silicone mat)
- Double boiler or old pot for melting
- Natural bristle or silicone brush (optional)
- Parchment paper (for drying or ironing method)

Method:

- Preheat oven to 150°C (300°F) or lower.
- Melt beeswax and damar resin in a double boiler. Stir regularly-resin takes ~10-15 minutes.
- Once fully melted, stir in jojoba oil.
- Place cotton fabric on prepared baking sheet.
- Pour or brush wax mixture evenly over the fabric.
- Bake for 1-3 minutes until wax fully saturates fabric.
- Remove from oven and spread evenly with a brush or tilt tray.
- Hang or lay flat to dry - ready in minutes!

Care Instructions:

- Wash in cold water with mild soap
- Air dry
- Avoid heat, microwaves, or hot water
- Refresh after 2-6 months with a fresh coat of wax mix
